 - I like playing soccer. (Me gusta jugar fútbol.)
 - I don't like homework. (No me gusta la tarea.)
 - I don't like waking up early. (No me gusta levantarme temprano.)

- I think English is important.
 - I think movies are fun.

✓ Estructura

In my opinion, + sentence

✓ Ejemplos

- In my opinion, school should start later.
 - In my opinion, soccer is the best sport.

My favorite + noun + is + noun/adjective

✓ Ejemplos

- My favorite food is pizza.
 - My favorite subject is English.
 - My favorite singer is Shakira.

★ **1. ¿Qué son los comparativos?**

Sirven para **comparar dos cosas**.

★ **2. Reglas y estructuras principales**

✓ **1. Adjetivos cortos (1 sílaba)**

Se añade **-er + than**

Structure:

A + be + adjective-er + than + B

Ejemplos:

- tall → **taller than**
- small → **smaller than**
- fast → **faster than**

Oraciones:

- **My house is bigger than yours.**
 - **Cats are faster than turtles.**

✓ **2. Adjetivos largos (2 o más sílabas)**

Se usa **more + adjective + than**

Ejemplos:

- beautiful → **more beautiful than**
- interesting → **more interesting than**

Oraciones:



- This book is more interesting than the movie.
- English is more important than art.

✓ **3. Comparativos irregulares**

- good → **better than**
- bad → **worse than**
- far → **farther/further than**

Oraciones:

- **Math is better than history.**
- **This test is worse than the last one.**

★ 1. ¿Qué son los superlativos?

Se usan para hablar de **lo máximo** dentro de un grupo.
(El más... la mejor... lo más...)

★ 2. Reglas y estructuras

✓ 1. Adjetivos cortos (1 sílaba)

Se añade **the + adjective-est**

Ejemplos:

- tall → **the tallest**
- small → **the smallest**

Oraciones:

- **He is the tallest in the class.**
 - **This is the smallest room.**
-

✓ 2. Adjetivos largos

Se usa **the most + adjective**

Ejemplos:

- interesting → **the most interesting**
- expensive → **the most expensive**

Oraciones:

- **This is the most interesting book I have.**
 - **It is the most expensive restaurant in town.**
-

✓ 3. Irregulares

- good → **the best**
- bad → **the worst**

Oraciones:

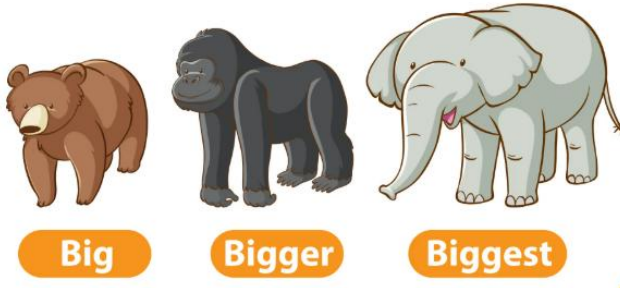
- **English is the best subject.**



- That was the worst day.
