✓ 3. Event details (detalles del evento)

Incluye:

- What (qué evento)
- When (fecha/hora)
- Where (lugar)
- Why (motivo)

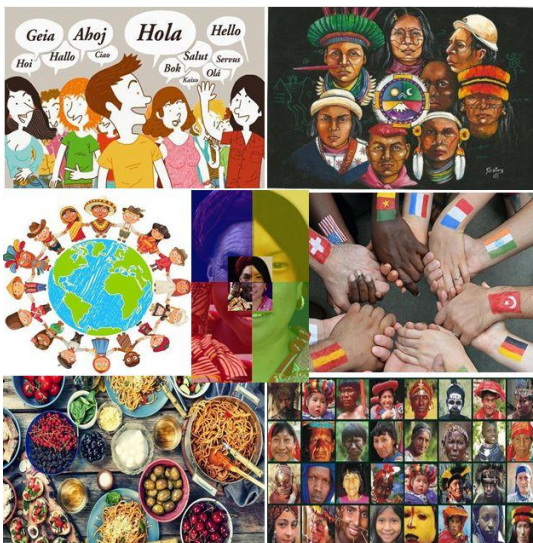
